GENEALOGY

An individual may search Death and Marriage indexes at no charge. Due to limited space, genealogists will be allowed to work in the office on a first-come, first-serve basis. A time limit may be necessary due to various circumstances. Records can only be pulled by office staff.

Birth records for genealogy are only available when the birth occurred 100 years ago, or more, to any applicant. A birth record that is less than 100 years old can only be obtained by the subject of the record, someone named on the record, or an heir with proof of death of the subject of the record.

Certified Copies: \$10.00 for the first copy and \$3.00 for each additional copy of the same record
